

## Supplemental Educational Services

2009-2010

During the 09-10 school year, fifty-eight companies were approved by the SC Department of Education to offer Supplemental Educational Services (SES), free tutoring, to eligible students in Title I schools. Of the original group of companies, 23 were ready to offer services to Colleton students. Of the 23 companies, 18 were listed as first choice for services. The number of students eligible to participate (369) was established once the cost of Choice transport for the year was determined. Funds that the federal government required the school district to set aside allowed the district to serve approximately 11% of eligible students. Below is a report of the number of students who participated in each Title I school and the number of students signed up with each provider.
