Requirements: All participants must be students enrolled in Colleton County School District. A \$40 registration fee is due on Monday, March 22nd. **Each contestant should be free of disciplinary referrals and at least a 3.0 GPA.** All Division II contestants are required to sell \$150 in either Sweetheart money or Ads for the program. You may sell one, or both, but you must sell \$150 between the two. The contestant with the highest sales in ads is awarded Miss Entrepreneurship. The contestant with the highest sales in signatures is awarded Miss Sweetheart. Division I contestants are required to sell \$75 in Sweetheart Money. The contestant with the highest sales in signatures is awarded Jr. Miss Sweetheart. These photos are for the program as well as used for the judges' decision in choosing Miss Photogenic.

Information: The Miss Cougar Pageants are fundraisers sponsored by the CCHS Chorus to benefit The Kermit Trevor Hudson Memorial Scholarship Fund. Two scholarships are given to local Colleton County School District students attending CSU and USC Salk. In addition, Miss Cougar (\$600) and Miss Senior (\$400) will receive monetary awards. The pageant is open to all students enrolled in Colleton County School District in grades K4-12. All contestants will compete in both casual and formal wear. Division II will have required interviews with the judges prior to the pageant.

Pageant Wear Guidelines

Both fun fashion and formal wear will be judged. Fun fashion is the contestants chance to show their personality. It is meant to be fun, but not sloppy. No ripped jeans or lounge wear will be allowed.

Formal wear is where contestants should show elegance and poise on stage, wearing a long evening gown for the older contestants and dressy short dress for the younger ones. Please adhere to the guidelines. Wear something that will make you feel spectacular. Elegance and good taste should dictate your choice. Please do not wear sloppy or distressed/rip clothing.

K4 - 5th grade - Sunday Dress/Dressy Holiday Style Short Dress/Maxi Dress/Evening Gown

6th - 8th grade - Evening Gown

9th - 12th grade - Pageant or Prom Style Evening Gown

Headshots

Most photogenic will be judged on the headshot that the contestant submits with her application on **Monday, March 22, 2021 at noon.**

Photos can be in color or black and white and should be no smaller than 4x6 and no larger than 8X10. A hard copy of the headshot must be submitted with the application and a digital copy emailed to Mrs. Drawdy at ssdrawdy@colleton.k12.sc.us. If you are having trouble with your headshot, contact Mrs. Drawdy **prior** to the due date for help. Applications/headshots are due on March 22, 2021. Please be aware that a headshot is from the chest up and not full body.

Rehearsals

We will have two mandatory rehearsals to make sure everyone is fully prepared for the pageant. Rehearsals will be on March 31, and April 21, both at 1:30 P.M. in the CCHS Performing Arts Center. **Bring your shoes, your mask and remain socially distanced!!!**

All the mandatory rehearsals are optional for the Division 1 contestants but are encouraged so they know where to walk.

Interviews/Bio Sheet

Division II contestants are required to attend a personal interview with the judges on the afternoon of the pageant. Each contestant will have a private interview with the judges. The interview questions come from the questions on the bio sheet included in the application packet.

Registration
